### Data Access and Exchange Roundtable

- € Ashley Jones-Mitchell provided an update on the closed-door data access and exchange roundtable that Accumulus Synergy is hosting on May 14, 2026 in partnership with Google.
  - ∅ The roundtable will convene thought leaders from industry, regulatory bodies, technology companies, and academia to identify barriers and enablers of global data access and exchange for better regulatory collaboration.
  - ∅ The output of this session will be co-developed policy recommendations that will be published in a public report.
  - ∅ Accumulus Synergy is partnering with Reagan Udall Foundation for the US FDA for a public meeting to solicit feedback on the public report in October 2026.
